

Mount Lindesay Highway Rosia Road to Stoney Camp Road Upgrade

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is undertaking an upgrade to the Mount Lindesay Highway between Rosia Road and Stoney Camp Road, Park Ridge South.

WHAT ARE WE DOING

- Widening the highway to four lanes.
- Upgrading the Highway's water run-off infrastructure.
- Upgrading the on-ramp at Stoney Camp Road and the off-ramp at Granger Road.
- Safety improvements, including upgrading the barriers.

BENEFITS

The project will:

- Improve safety for all road users.
- Reduce potential for traffic incidents.
- Retain freight efficiency and allow adequate capacity for freight.
- Improve traffic flow and road capacity.

This \$20 million project upgrade is funded by the Queensland Government.
