6801 gifts were collected!

WHERE DO THE GIFTS GO?

The gifts are taken straight from the event to GIVIT's office in Brisbane. There, the team box up the presents and send them directly to Child Safety Centres around Queensland who provide GIVIT with the number of gifts required for the kids in their care.

Every single gift is given to a child in need.
